Also, the bonds sold for the construction of the south hall of the Convention Center were \$150,000,000 and the total project costs were approximately \$169,000,000.

Councilwoman Smith stated recycling regulations were approved as well as the ballot question limiting tobacco uses in public places. A referendum for legislature to know what

Southern Nevadans wanted and whether there could be more control on deciding some of those issues was also approved.

Councilman Buck stated the monorail project was passed by both Houses of Congress. There was a billion dollar bonus for Nevada since all the privately funded and non-federal funds would count toward the local match for funding. Also, the RTC approved guidelines of 3 1/2 percent of planning eligibility would be used for aesthetic enhancement for bridges and roadways.

Councilman Buck stated the President's Energy and Water Appropriations Act had provided \$725,000 for studying the Lower Las Vegas Wetlands Wash and an additional \$100,000 for the study of the Las Vegas Wash in the City of North Las Vegas had also been approved.

Mayor Pro Tempore Robinson stated the grant for \$120,000 was approved which awarded the building of 70 senior units in the Tonopah area; however, there may be a complications purchasing some other apartments. He stated he would know more when he met with the Executive Director.
