Development and Flood Control Manager Lenny Badger stated the National Flood Insurance Program had upgraded the City of North Las Vegas' rating from a Class 8 to a Class 7. A Class 7 rated city in the Community Rating System would be in the 86 percentile of approximately 940 eligible communities. Residents living in a flood district who are required

to obtain flood insurance would receive a 5% discount for a total discount of 15% on their flood insurance rate. The City received the rating increase by meeting various credible activities such as providing flood awareness and flood zone information to the public through billboards and flyers, a strong water management program, and inspection and maintenance of the storm drain system and flood control channels in the City.

<u>Brian Walsh, D.R. Horton, 6845 Escondido Street, Las Vegas,</u> stated he would consider redesigning the front of the dwelling if Staff and Council thought it would be more appropriate.

Councilwoman Smith stated residents would not enjoy their balconies to the fullest extent if access could only be achieved through a window. She stated she experienced conflicted feelings caused by this item because she had strongly supported the balcony design guidelines. She stated the needs for this development were different. The property would be a townhome development and not an apartment complex. Police Chief Paresi stated the City of Boston had created a "red light district" which later had been named the "combat zone" as police struggled to contain activity in the district. He stated studies had proved declining property values, commercial business failure, and commercial business relocation resulted in neighborhoods located near Sexually Orientated Business zones. Public safety would be compromised by the designation of these districts.

Councilwoman Smith stated the area the County had chosen would be in the middle of Aliante and urged Staff and developers to take appropriate action.

Councilman Buck stated she wanted the item brought before the Regional Planning Coalition. City Manager Fritsch stated a letter would be drafted to the County Manager, Thom Reilly to oppose the proposed zones and Staff would attend the County Public Hearing.
