Brad Jones, Project Manager, WRG Design Inc., 2260 Corporate Circle Suite 430, Las

Vegas. appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Jones stated his clients were in agreement with all the conditions but he would like to discuss condition number eight. Mr. Jones requested the secondary access be limited to emergency vehicles only and/or the requirement of the condition be negotiated with the Fire Department and Traffic Operations.

LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, AND THE DANIEL S. MOSELY REV. TRUST AGREEMENT 1996, PROPERTY OWNERS, FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, LAND USE ELEMENT, TO CHANGE THE CURRENT DESIGNATION OF VERY LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL AND NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL ON PROPERTY GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF COLEMAN STREET AND SAN MIGUEL AVENUE. (ASSOCIATED ITEM NO. 5, ORDINANCE NO. 1795, ZN-17-03)

Mayor Montandon disclosed Thomas Lozzi had worked on his last campaign. Mayor Montandon stated he did not have a financial relationship or stand to receive financial gain from Mr. Lozzi's business transactions.

Councilman Eliason disclosed the law firm, Kummer, Kaempfer, Bonner & Renshaw, who employed Robert Gronauer, was currently representing Councilman Eliason's employer.

Development Services Director Kristaponis stated the Planning Commission had approved zoning on the back portion of the property to neighborhood commercial and medium low

density residential. The applicant requested two pieces of the property to remain neighborhood commercial and four parcels zoned professional office. Director Kristaponis stated she had spoken with Staff because the majority of property owners with property zoned professional office requested the property be changed to community commercial because the market for professional office was limited. She stated the issue before the Council was to rezone the four parcels professional office, even though a good number of professional office zoned property was currently vacant.

Mayor Montandon opened the Public Hearing.

Robert Gronauer, 3800 Howard Hughes Parkway, Las Vegas, represented the applicants. Mr. Gronauer stated the property consisted of 40 acres. It was located near the recently approved Outback Steakhouse. The boundaries of the property were Craig Road to the north, San Miguel to the south, Coleman Street to the east and Simmons Street to the west. Mr. Gronauer stated his clients would prefer the entire 40 acres zoned commercial but felt it would be in the best interest for all concerned parties if the property had multiple zoning uses.

Mr. Gronauer stated professional office zoned property would typically be one story buildings which would be harmonious with the nearby ranch estates property as required by the City's code. He stated the amendment to the master plan would request two parcels zoned neighborhood commercial and four parcels zoned professional office.

Mayor Montandon stated deciding between the economic highest and best use versus future planning was difficult. The office market for the City was very low. He declined to define the existing markets based on the zoning. Mayor Montandon stated commercial use would be the highest and best use but the problem existed with multiple owners and multiple parcels. He had seen successful professional office located behind commercial properties throughout the Las Vegas valley. He did not want to dismiss the proposed request for zone changes based on the fact professional office had not been successful in North Las Vegas because it could be successful in the future.

Mayor Montandon closed the Public Hearing.
