Density Residential among Low Density Residential. The proposed density for the associated Planned Unit Development (PUD) was approximately 5.44 dwelling units per acre and the aggregated density for the entire International Village was approximately 6.87 dwelling units per acre. The highest densities adjoin the Carefree Senior Housing complex on the north side of the development which was 10.25 dwelling units per acre and created a transition from the highest densities to the interior of the development. Staff recommended approval of the overall development, as did the Planning Commission.

<u>Jennifer Lazovich, 3800 Howard Hughes Parkway, Las Vegas,</u> represented the applicant and requested Council approval.

Councilman Eliason stated he had received an e-mail that there was a possibility the property could be landlocked and asked Ms. Lazovich if that issue had been addressed. Ms. Lazovich responded there were some parcels the applicant was not able to acquire; however, she advised the development would not be gated and there would be two ingress/egress locations, one on and off of Allen Lane and one on and off of Valley Drive, to provide access to the interior parcels.
