Mayor Montandon opened the Public Hearing.

Public Works Director Jim Bell explained there was a change of condition. The Clark County Commission had approved a vacation on the north side of La Madre Way between Bruce Street and Harold Street on January 17, 2006 (Condition No. 3). The Planning Commission supported the vacation however, staff was in opposition. With the approval by the Clark County Commission to vacate the north side of LaMadre Way, denial of this application would create a street that was vacated on one side and improved on the other. That would not be a desirable situation.

Councilman Buck questioned if, as a member of the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition (SNRPC), there was an agreement made that changes to land on the borders of the cities and the county, the other entities would be notified. City Manager Rose responded it was his understanding that anything that had a regional impact should have been presented to the SNRPC for consideration. Planning and Development Director Jory Stewart was unaware of the status of LaMadre Way specific to the Master Plan of Streets and Highways. If the street was not shown on the Master Plan, the SNRPC would not have known to consider it. Public Works Director Bell added at one time, LaMadre Way was a collector road but had since been deleted from the Master Plan of Streets & Highways as several sections had not been completed. Councilman Buck felt it would have been a courteous gesture by the County to have had a discussion with the City regarding the vacation of half of this street. It was her hope the County would be contacted to try to enhance communication between the agencies.

<u>Jennifer Lazovich, 3800 Howard Hughes Parkway, Las Vegas,</u> concurred with Public Works Director Bell's comments and stated the County's vacation necessitated the need for the vacation on North Las Vegas side as well.
