He explained the property was a remnant piece surrounded by the residential district and was master planned at 13 units per acre. He explained the alternative was to change to Neighborhood Commercial to comply with the surrounding neighborhood which fronted North 5<sup>th</sup> Street. There was one access drive on North 5<sup>th</sup> Street and he felt the commercial zoning complied with the surrounding neighborhood.

City Attorney Carie Torrence explained conditions were not placed on the ordinance, but could be added to the site plan. City Manager Rose explained an option would be to direct Staff to add the conditions at the Planning Commission. Planning and Zoning Manager Marc Jordan explained that at the same time the amendment and rezoning were submitted, the applicant filed for the use permits for the C-store, car wash and convenience store which had been approved by the Planning Commission. He explained that the zoning ordinance had requirements in place not to exceed 65 decibels at the property line.

Councilwoman Buck expressed her concern regarding the noise from the car wash affecting the neighbors and requested operating hours be limited.
