Andreas Adrian, Majestic Properties, 4815 West Russell Road, # 107, Las Vegas confirmed Mr. Contreras' claims of prior interest in the property at a much higher price. Mr. Contreras had recently received an appraisal of \$344,000 and stated he was willing to sell the property to the City for 10 percent above appraised value. Mayor Montandon repeated the City had to follow procedures. The City Attorney's Office could delay filing the condemnation for a few weeks while negotiations took place. Mayor Montandon reiterated the City wanted to offer everyone a fair deal, but had to begin the process at this time in

order for the North 5th Street project to proceed. Mr. Contreras felt the City was remiss in informing potential buyers the intention was to widen the street, which prevented him from selling the property earlier at a higher price. Councilwoman Buck explained City staff was

honest with the public and would not withhold such information.
