- 1) Connie opened the meeting welcoming everyone and introducing Mark Etzback of Redflex.
- 2) Mark gave a PowerPoint presentation regarding red light cameras. The cameras are able to record up to six lanes of traffic. There will be two test cameras placed in the City of North Las Vegas for one year to record the number of drivers running red lights and causing accidents. The cameras will be unmarked and will just collect the data for the first six months. After that, a sign will be posted at one location advising that the camera is there. The second location will be a test control and remain unposted. The cameras will again collect the data for the next six months. Due to great results that Redflex has experienced in other cities, the data should show a decrease in the number of red light infractions and accidents.

Redflex reviews and verifies the data before advising the PD of a violator. The data is reviewed to make sure that a violation had occurred and to make sure that the license plate can be clearly seen. It is then reviewed for quality control. The information, including a clear picture showing the violation, will then be sent to the PD who will review and then issue citations.

Redflex will front the money to install and maintain the cameras. Money from the citations will be used to pay back Redflex and install cameras in new locations. It will also be used toward educating the public on red light cameras and traffic education for young drivers.

3) Oscar started the Round Robin by thanking the Chief and the Department for their support of the annual bazaar at St. Christopher's.

Ted asked if the videos from the red light cameras will be maintained for a certain amount of time.

Chief Paresi reminded the council that Safe Halloween will be held on Wednesday, 10/31/07, at the Home Depot on Craig from 6 p.m. until 9 p.m. We're expecting between 2500 - 3500 people to attend.

The November meeting and training scheduled for November 19th at the Texas Station Casino has been cancelled.
